## French Immersion Certificate Requirements

To obtain the French Immersion Certificate, students must complete <u>four</u> language courses (FIF1D, FIF2D, FIF3U, and FIF4U) and a minimum of <u>six</u> courses in other subjects taught in French.

The following table outlines the French Immersion courses Sir Wilfrid Laurier Secondary School offers at each grade level.
