# **Student Course Policy and Evaluation Handout**

#### **Course Description:**

This course emphasizes instrumental musical literacy through performance, appreciation, and analysis of musical forms as a member of the band. Senior students will rehearse, perform, discuss, analyze and reflect on music as it relates to their individual and group experience in this course.

Use critical analysis in responding to, analyzing, reflecting on, interpreting, and understanding music with respect to how it enhances personal development and society thru performance.

#### **Attendance and Behaviour Policy:**
